*to the Government Gazette of Mauritius No. 131 of 7 December 2019**Government Notice No. 254 of 2019***THE MEDICAL COUNCIL ACT****Regulations made by the Minister, after consultation
with the Medical Council, under section 42 of
the Medical Council Act**

1. These regulations may be cited as the Medical Council (Continuing Professional Development) (Amendment) Regulations 2019.
2. In these regulations –
“principal regulations” means the Medical Council (Continuing Professional Development) Regulations 2016.
3. Regulation 9 of the principal regulations is amended, in paragraph (1)(a), by adding the following new subparagraphs –
 - (v) is registered with the Council during the period August to December of that particular year;
 - (vi) has resumed practice after coming back to Mauritius from overseas during the period August to December of that particular year.
4. The Schedule of the principal regulations is amended –
 - (a) in Part I, by adding the following new item and its corresponding entry –
 4. Approved online CPD course or e-training programme (for at least one hour)

(b) in Part II, by deleting item 1 and its corresponding entries and replacing it by the following item and its corresponding entries –

1. Registered medical practitioner 4 per day with
attending local/international a maximum
conference of 8 per
conference

5. These regulations shall be deemed to have come into operation on 1 January 2019.
