

Government Notice No. 219 of 2013

THE MEDICAL COUNCIL ACT

**Regulations made by the Minister, after consultation
with the Medical Council, under section 42(1)(a)
of the Medical Council Act**

1. These regulations may be cited as the Medical Council (Exemption of Non-citizens from Examinations) Regulations 2013.

2. In these regulations –

“Act” means the Medical Council Act;

“regulatory body”, in relation to a foreign country, means the body which is empowered under the law of that country to register general practitioners.

3. For the purposes of section 22(3) of the Act, section 22(1)(ca) of the Act shall not apply to a non-citizen wishing to be temporarily registered as a general practitioner under section 26 of the Act where he establishes to the satisfaction of the Council that –

- (a) he is duly registered as a general practitioner with the regulatory body of the country where he was practising medicine immediately before he applies for registration in Mauritius; and
- (b) he has practised as a general practitioner for a minimum period of 3 years in that country.
