THE MEDICAL COUNCIL ACT

Regulations made by the Minister, after consultation with the Medical Council, under section 42(1)(a) of the Medical Council Act

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Medical Council (Exemption of Non-citizens from Examinations) Regulations 2013.
- In these regulations
 - "Act" means the Medical Council Act;
 - "regulatory body", in relation to a foreign country, means the body which is empowered under the law of that country to register-general practitioners.
- 3. For the purposes of section 22(3) of the Act, section 22(1)(ca) of the Act shall not apply to a non-citizen wishing to be temporarily registered as a general practitioner under section 26 of the Act where he establishes to the satisfaction of the Council that—
 - (a) he is duly registered as a general practitioner with the regulatory body of the country where he was practising medicine immediately before he applies for registration in Mauritius; and
 - (b) he has practised as a general practitioner for a minimum period of 3 years in that country.
